

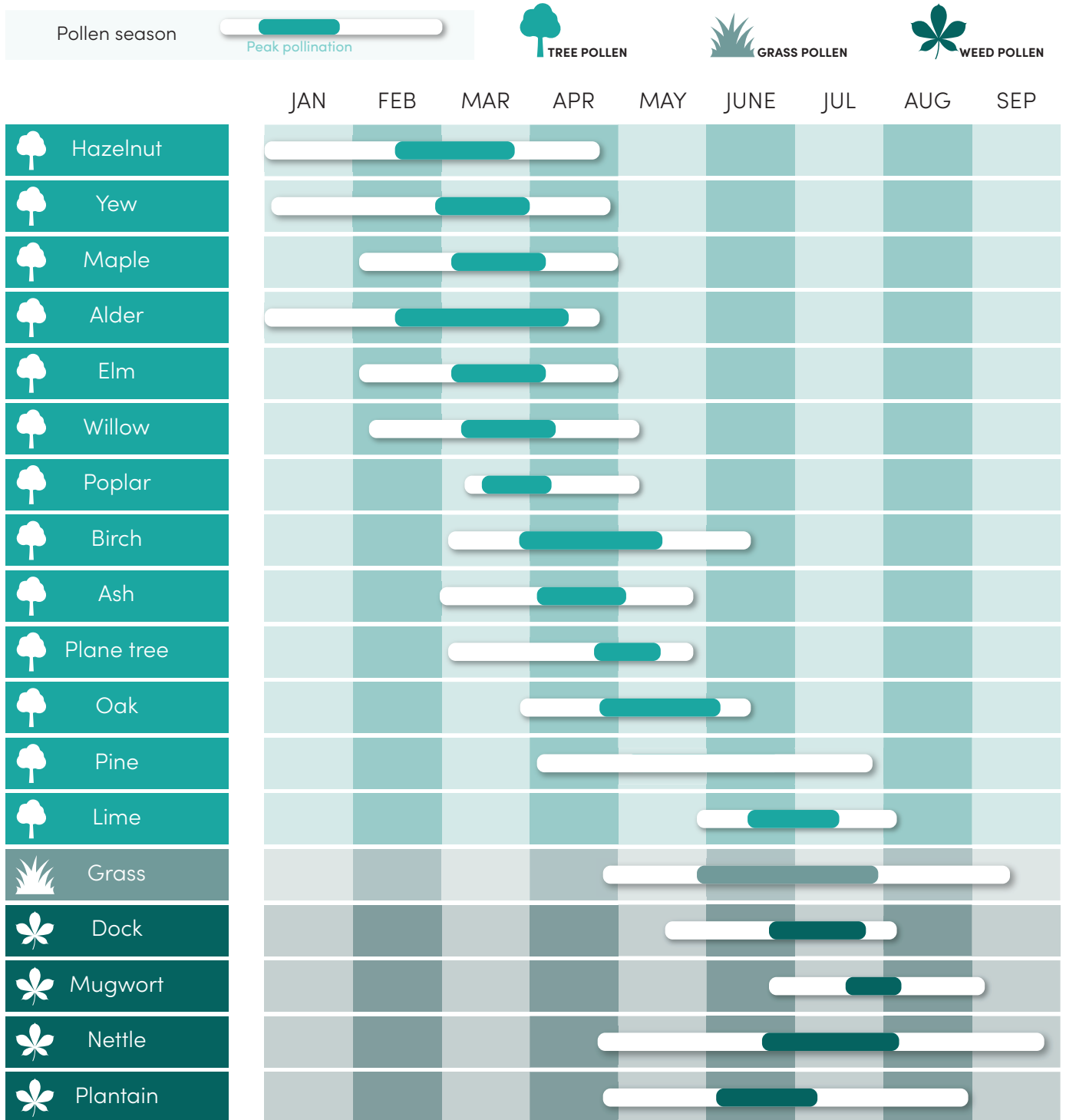
PREVENTING RESPIRATORY DISCOMFORT IN HORSES


Pollen is present during spring and summer. It is in fields and surrounding stables. Pollen significantly increases the risk of asthma attacks.

Anticipate pollen peaks to avoid prolonged discomfort.
